- To understand the importance of expressive arts and ways we can promote these in outdoor provision and everyday practice and provisions
- ❖ To value child participation their contributions and consider how we can sustain and promote their ideas and suggestions
- ❖ To use a holistic and child centred approach which promotes diversity
- ❖ To reflect and consider how we can value art in the local community, society and the wider world
- ❖ To understand how expressive art can impact and influence emotions, behaviour and other aspects of learning and development
- ❖ To consider how we can record and display children's, efforts, achievements and contributions
