



ENCOURAGING POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR IN THE EARLY YEARS

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Aim of the session:

To work together in partnership with parents to promote consistent messages and strategies; which support and encourage positive behaviour in the early years

Objectives of the session:

- ❖ To reflect upon the strategies that are used and the effectiveness of these
- ❖ To discuss and consider why children may become challenging
- ❖ To review and discuss factors which can influence a child's behaviour
- ❖ To consider age, stage and development of children as individuals to meet and promote their needs
- ❖ To reflect upon the emotions of children and the importance of their emotional and social development and well-being and the “**emotional saving bank**”
- ❖ To reflect upon the importance of being an effective communicator when supporting young children to learn skills
- ❖ To promote consistent and fair messages for children to enable to learn about acceptable and inappropriate behaviours
- ❖ To support and encourage children to develop the skills to share and turn take
- ❖ To consider the behaviours which young children display and understand why
- ❖ To consider the importance of praise, encouragements and reward
