

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students must inform the setting Manager before 8.30am if they are unable to attend due to sickness or other appointments
- Students must discuss their studies and expectations of learning, to gain knowledge, understanding and experience as they develop their skills
- Students must be positive role models and treat the team, parents and children with respect and dignity at all times promoting inclusive practices
- Students must use age appropriate and acceptable language at all times
- Students must manage children's behaviour appropriately and seek support and advice if unsure
- Students must wear sensible footwear whilst on duty and appropriate clean clothing which is suitable. The team do not wear bracelets, long earrings or inappropriate jewellery to reduce accidents and incidents
- Students mobile phones must be locked in the filing cabinet during the session following procedures
- Students must operate safe internet usage both on and off the premises. They are not permitted to make any reference whatsoever to Caterpillar Corner children or staff, past or present on any social networking sites.
- Students should inform the Manager if they are prescribed or taking any medication which may affect their ability to care for children during their placement
- All students must adhere to ALL policies within the setting, we have a NO smoking on site policy which must be adhered to.
- Students must follow the safeguarding and confidentiality policy at all times
- Students will seek the advice of the Manager should they require support or any additional information during their placement.
